



GUIDELINES TO RESET EVE-T1 TO FACTORY SETTINGS – Windows 8.1

Purpose:

This document is to reset Eve-T1 to the factory settings and will remove all of your existing data on your Eve-T1 and install Windows 8.1 with Bing.

Hardware requirements:

- **Scenario 1:** You are able to access Windows OS system → PC Settings
 - OTG cable (micro USB B male to USB B Female)
 - USB Stick 8GB
 - PC/Laptop

- **Scenario 2:** You are not able to access Windows OS system
 - OTG cable (micro USB B male to USB B Female)
 - USB Stick 8GB
 - USB hub
 - Input devices: USB mouse and keyboard
 - PC/Laptop

Software requirements:

- Download recovery image ([Download link](#))
- USB Image Tool 1.70 ([Download link](#))

Instructions:

Part – 1: Mount Recovery Image to 8 GB USB stick

1. Download **Eve_Recovery_v.01.img** and the **USB Image Tool**
2. Connect the 8GB USB Stick to your PC.
3. Extract the USB Image Tool.zip file and right click on **“USB Image Tool.exe”** and **“run as administrator”**
4. Select the 8GB USB and click on **“Restore”** and navigate to the **“Eve_Recovery_v.01.img”** and press **“OK”**.

Part – 2: Reset Eve-T1 to factory settings

Note:

- Before you initiate, you must charge Eve-T1's battery to full.
- All your personal data will be wiped out of Eve-T1.

Scenario 1: You are able to access Windows OS system → PC Settings

1. Connect the 8GB USB stick to Eve-T1 with OTG cable
2. At Windows desktop, swipe from right → press “Settings” → “Update and Recovery” → “Recovery” → at Choose an option screen select “Use a Device” → “Use a EFI USB Device”
3. Once recovery, process is finished your device is restored to factory settings.
4. When you start Eve-T1 for the first time, you need to do the following:
 - a. Your Eve-T1 will be in Finnish Language and do
 - b. You can download the desired language packages from the [here](#) and set your language through PC Settings.
 - c. Before restarting your device, you must install an important firmware update on Eve-T1. ([Download link](#)).
 - d. At initiation a Sysprep Window will pop up, click on the check box “**Yleistää**” (This means “**Generalize**” in English) and press **OK**.
 - e. Eve-T1 will reboot and you will go through normal windows setup.

Scenario 2: You are not able to access Windows OS system

1. Connect the USB hub to Eve-T1 with OTG cable and plug in keyboard, mouse and 8GB USB stick to your USB Hub.
2. To reach to UEFI menu, turn on your Eve-T1: press and hold “Power Button” until it turns off repeat the process unless you reach to the recovery menu.
3. In the recovery menu →select “Advanced options” → at Choose an option screen select “Use a Device” → “Use a EFI USB Device”.
4. Once recovery, process is finished your device is restored to factory settings.
5. When you start Eve-T1 for the first time, you need to do the following:
 - a. Your Eve-T1 will be in Finnish Language and do
 - b. You can download the desired language packages from the [here](#) and set your language through PC Settings.
 - c. Before restarting your device, you must install an important firmware update on Eve-T1. ([Download link](#)).
 - d. At initiation a Sysprep Window will pop up, click on the check box “**Yleistää**” (This means “**Generalize**” in English) and press **OK**.
